Your Social Security Number (SSN) may be suspended in the next 24 hours due to potentially suspicious or unauthorized activity .

We're reaching out to inform you that your Social Security Number has been suspended due to the FTC identifying unauthorized activity tied to your identity in Texas.

Your case has now been referred to the Department of Justice for prosecution under the Criminal Code Act of 1950, as well as additional state-level offenses in Texas, including violations of the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002:

1. **Money Laundering* Violation of 18 U.S.C.§2101*
2. **Theft by Deception* Violation of 18 U.S.C.§1986*
3. **Drug Trafficking* Violation of 21 U.S.C.§258*

A fresh legal action has been brought against you as of today.
